

Earthborn Furniture Glaze is a clear, water-based glaze designed to protect painted furniture. Glazed surfaces will remain durable with a soft sheen finish; repelling water, dust and grease.

1. Coverage

Up to 9m² per litre.

5. Uses

Earthborn Furniture Glaze can be used over Earthborn Eco Chic Claypaint for furniture and offers protection to various decorative effects, including Earthborn Crackle.

6. Ingredients

Water, acrylic binder, fumed silica, coalescent, wax, defoaming agent, amine, synthetic preservative (methylisothiazolinone).

7. Properties

Clear, low sheen and durable finish.

8. Preparation

The surface should be clean, dry and free from dust and grease. Non-absorbent or gloss surfaces should be lightly sanded first.

9. Instructions for Use

Stir before use.

10. Application

Apply over the painted surface with a brush, working in smooth strokes. When dry, apply a further coat for optimum protection.

11. Colouring – Depends on if products needs it)

12. Drying Time

Touch dry in 1-2 hours. Allow 6-12 hours before overpainting. Maximum durability will be achieved after 10 days.

13. Tools

Brush.

14. Cleaning

Clean tools with water.

15. Maintenance

Painted surfaces can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge and water, do not use abrasive or micro-fibre cloths. Avoid excessive rubbing as this may leave a visible mark when dry. The use of harsh detergents to remove stains is not recommended.

16. Storage & Disposal

Keep containers sealed and store in a dry, cool, frost-free place.

Any leftover paint should not be emptied into drains or watercourses but allowed to dry and reference made to local authority disposal guidelines.
