DESCRIPTION

Johnstone's Trade Flortred is a solvent based, semi-gloss coating with added polyurethane to provide increased durability and be harder wearing. It is resistant to mild chemicals, water, oil and grease in areas subject to light and medium levels of traffic such as walkways. To further boost the slip resistance of Johnstone's Trade Flortred, use with Johnstone's Trade Anti-Slip Additive. Suitable for exterior use to highlight walkways, car park spaces and other markings. Not suitable for use on large external areas.

COVERAGE

DRYING TIME



Recoatable after 16-24 hours under normal conditions. The coating is fully cured in 7 days.

TRANSPORTATION & STORAGE

PREPARATION

All surfaces to be painted should be clean, dry and free from dust, laitance, loose and flaking material. New concrete or cement should be allowed to mature for several months before painting. Very dense smooth concrete surfaces (such as power floated concrete) normally require to be acid etched before painting in order to promote satisfactory adhesion. APPLICATION



Ensure maximum ventilation during application and drying. When applying to large interior surfaces or in confined spaces, wear a suitable cartridge respirator or air-fed respiratory protective equipment. Stir well before use. Apply by brush or roller which should be fully loaded for best results. Apply paint evenly and avoid overspreading. To ease application, the first coat may be thinned with up to 5% by volume of White Spirit. Allow to dry overnight before applying a second coat, if required. If more than one can of a colour is to be used in the same area, intermix before use.

CLEANING



Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Replace lid firmly. Clean equipment immediately after use with White Spirit or Turpentine substitute. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.
